About the Training

Have you ever been challenged with a tricky interview question that left you wondering if it translated? The Deaf and Hard of Hearing Employment Consortium (DHHEC) is seeking nationally certified and/or Missouri intermediate and above interpreters that enjoy interpreting in employment settings. Training topics will include employment settings ranging from interpreting the interview process to job training. This training will enhance your skills and provide the specialized skills needed to interpret employment settings.

Training participants will learn:

- **How to effectively interpret the interview process beginning with the initial phone interview through the second interview**
- **Interpreter utilization in common employment settings and the function of individuals in employment services**
- **The interpreters role in post employment training**

The DHHEC comprised of Vocational Rehabilitation, Alternative Opportunities, MERS, and Paraquad will create a registry of interpreters trained in the specialization of employment settings. Training participants will be given an opportunity to be included on the DHHEC registry.
